## Two Banks with Local Branches Taken Over by New Owners

Two banks with branches in San Diego County have been shut down by federal regulators.

Temecula Valley Bank's seven offices in San Diego County will reopen as branches of First Citizens Bank and Trust Company.

Vineyard Bank's branch in San Diego will reopen as a branch of California Bank and Trust.

Account holders have been told that their money is safe. They will automatically become customers of the new owners.

Anyone with accounts at either bank can still write checks or use ATM cards this weekend.
