



ATM/DEBIT CARD PROTECTION

ATMs are convenient and provide many of the banking services you need, when you need them. To protect your funds and help ensure your safety when using an ATM, here are some important tips you should keep in mind.

Protecting the Use of Your ATM Card:

- Your ATM card is the key to your accounts. Never disclose your Personal Identification Number (PIN) to anyone.
- Protect your PIN. Memorize it. If your PIN is safe, your card is safe.
- Never use your name, street number, telephone number or date of birth as your PIN.
- After completing a transaction, review your receipt and keep a copy for your records.
- Immediately notify CB&T if your card is lost or stolen.

ATM Safety.

Using an ATM:

- Be aware of your surroundings, especially at night.
- Always shield your PIN with your hand or body when conducting any transaction.
- Park close to the ATM, in a well-lit area.
- Look carefully at the ATM and do not use the machine if something does not look right. Use the same awareness when using your Debit Card at gas stations.
- Do not display your cash. Pocket it and count it later at a safe place.
- When requesting a receipt, take it with you to avoid disclosing account information.
- When using a drive-up ATM, make sure the passenger windows are closed and your doors are locked.
- Do not accept offers of help from strangers. If you have a problem or question, contact a branch office.
